#### **Abstract:**

This collection contains the original papers of descendants of Roger Conant, founder of Naumkeg and one of the Old Planters of Beverly. There are some materials documenting the life of Roger Conant, but the bulk of the collection relates to later Conant family members who lived in Beverly in the 17<sup>th</sup>, 18<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup> centuries. They were farmers and tradespeople. John Conant of the sixth generation was constable and tax collector and his records include names of many Beverly residents. The collection continues into the twentieth century with correspondence relating to other family members, and some documentation from the Conant Family Association.

#### **Provenance:**

The provenance of most materials in the collection is not known. Accession numbers when available are given in the notes column, but in most cases there is no record of the donor.

#### **Conservation/Processor's Note:**

All documents were in folders in no particular order. Some folders were marked with a specific name but some were more generally titled "Conant." In Series II, documents were collected in folders by the name most prominently associated with the document (many documents refer to more than one family member). The folders have been arranged within the series chronologically by birthdate of the Conant family member, and chronologically by the date of the document if known within each folder. Folder 12, which includes the papers of John Conant (1743-1809), is an exception. Those documents with accession numbers were kept together in one folder, and those that came from the Wenham Historical Association are also together, regardless of date.

The original documents in this collection are fragile, and in some cases torn and/or incomplete. Some receipts were in plastic sleeves. Staples were removed and replaced with plastic clips.

#### **Biographical/Historical Note**

Roger Conant was born in East Budleigh, England 1593. In 1623 he emigrated to New England with his wife Sarah. After a few years in Plymouth and then Cape Ann, Roger founded Naumkeag, which was later named Salem, in 1626, and was the first governor of the settlers there. In 1635 Roger along with four other settlers, later called the Old Planters, received a land grant on the Bass River side of Salem. Roger built a house on his 200 acres at what was then the head of the Bass River, on an Indian Path that led to Wenham Lake. (From *Life of Roger Conant*, by Frederick Odell Conant, 1926) Roger and Sarah Conant had eight children. Roger gave his son Lot the homestead in 1666, but leased the house for his remaining years. Succeeding generations of Conants, many descended from Lot, lived and farmed in Beverly.

#### **Scope and Content Note**

The Conant Family Papers collection includes original documents of descendants of Roger Conant dating from the early 1700's through the late 1800's. These documents consist of bills, receipts, deeds, tax assessments, and inventories relating to the second through the eighth generations of Conant family members, most of whom lived in Beverly. A large portion of the documents are financial in nature and many are concerned with the division of Conant family land. Materials relating to the life of Roger Conant can be found in Series I. Series II is separated into folders according to family member in order of birthdate. Folder 12 contains the documents of John Conant (1743-1809), who was the constable and tax collector. This folder is subdivided into three subseries including receipts and tax assessments referencing many Beverly residents. Series III includes materials relating to the Roger Conant Family Association.
