

Call to Artists for the juried *Colors of Beverly*Community Art Exhibit

Historic Beverly announces a call for entries for the Colors of Beverly Community Art Exhibit.

This Call for Art is open to all artists ages 18 and over. Submissions must be original works of visual art; **photography is welcome.** Original works must be two-dimensional and not exceed 36" in any direction (including frame). Up to 2 artwork submissions are welcome. Works must be representative of the theme of *Colors of Beverly* from an artist's viewpoint; traditional and abstract artwork is encouraged.

Colors of Beverly will be on display in Historic Beverly's second floor gallery from February 14, 2024 – June 1, 2024. All pieces will be displayed, this is a jury for prizes show.

Deadline for submissions: Saturday, February 3rd before 4pm

Delivery of All Work: To properly record, jury and install all accepted pieces, all work must be delivered to the Cabot House located at 117 Cabot Street between Wednesday, January 24th and Saturday, February 3rd. Drop-off times are as follows:

Wednesday, January 24th: 9:30am-4pm
Thursday, January 25th: 12-8pm
Friday, January 26th: 9:30am-4pm
Saturday, January 27th: 9:30am-4pm
Saturday, January 27th: 9:30am-4pm
Saturday, February 3rd: 10am-4pm

We are closed on Sundays, Mondays & Tuesdays. We will not accept your artwork before January 24th or after February 3rd, there are no exceptions.

Note: Work MUST be delivered in-person to Historic Beverly. You can send a representative on your behalf to deliver and/or pick up your artwork for you.

Mark all accepted artwork with the artist's name, address, city/state/zip, phone, email, title of piece, dimensions (w" x h" x d") or weight (no more than 100 lbs) and sale price. Complete a *Historic Beverly* loan agreement and submit with your artwork. Loan agreements are required for all artwork, no matter if it is accepted into the exhibit or not.

Artists are responsible for all payments associated with submissions:

An application must be filled out for each entry. Entry fee is \$10.00 per piece, a fee paid by cash, check or credit card. Checks made payable to *Historic Beverly* (you can make out one check for all fees). Fees are non-refundable.

Presentation: All accepted work must be framed, gallery-wrapped or finished on the edges and ready to hang at delivery with a sturdy wire hanging system. Any delivered work that does not meet the standard of the juror's decision will not be installed.

Art Sales: All art sales are subject to Historic Beverly's commission of 30% for Historic Beverly members, 50% for non-members. All work must be for sale.

Insurance: Historic Beverly will insure all work from the date of arrival at the Museum through the stated pick-up dates. The maximum insurance amount covers up to an artist's value of \$2000, with a \$500 deductible payable by the artist. Art left beyond the final pick-up date of June 8th at 4pm will not be insured.

In-person Pick-up of Exhibited Work Takes Place on the Following Dates:

Monday, June 3rd: 9:30am-4pm
Tuesday, June 4th: 9:30am-4pm
Friday, June 7th: 9:30am-4pm
Wednesday, June 5th: 9:30am-4pm
Saturday, June 8th: 9:30am-4pm

Work left beyond June 8th at 4:00 PM will be charged \$5 per day per piece, payable at late pickup.

Please note:

- Accepted works must remain on exhibit for the duration of the exhibit. No works can be substituted for pieces that were accepted by the juror. There are no exceptions.
- Although all care will be exercised, Historic Beverly cannot be responsible for any loss or damage while on exhibit.
- Historic Beverly reserves the right to create or use digital images of all submitted artwork and to use those images only for exhibition publicity and for archival and historical purposes.
- Historic Beverly is not responsible for artwork left unclaimed past pick up date of June 8th at 4:00 PM.
- Dates, specifications & fees are non-negotiable.
